Fiction

The Academy by Elin Hilderbrand. This has been described as an "irresistible, deliciously scandalous story" taking place during one year at a New England boarding school. Scandalous items appear on the students' phones, secrets are exposed, and many lives are forever changed. A fun ride!

What We Can Know by Ian McEwan. This new novel is filled with secrets and surprises. We are led from 2014 to 2119: the future where the world has been changed by rising seas and nuclear accidents. The book is a "masterpiece" of mystery, secrets, and surprises. A love story of the past and future.
