WATERMAN VILLAGE CULINARY DRESS CODE

Gracious living is the charm of Waterman Village. The dining experiences allow everyone to meet and join in fellowship. To maintain proper decorum, residents and their guests will adhere to the following dress codes as defined by the residents of Waterman Village.

LODGE MAIN DINING ROOM & SAVOR ~ LUNCH - Monday through Saturday

- Casual attire is acceptable.
- Shorts and skirts that extend to mid-thigh are acceptable.
- Jeans of all fabrics and colors are acceptable.

LODGE MAIN DINING ROOM & SAVOR ~ DINNER – Every day except major holidays

- Women – Nice casual attire is acceptable. (Dresses, shorts, skirts, capris, slacks, shirts and tops)
- Men – Collared shirts and dress shorts/slacks are acceptable.
- Jeans of all fabrics and colors are acceptable.

The following attire is not permitted at any time: sweatpants, sport clothes, tee shirts, flip-flops, hats, caps, and overalls.

LODGE MAIN DINING ROOM & SAVOR ~ SUNDAY BRUNCH AND MAJOR HOLIDAYS

- Women – Nice casual attire is acceptable. (Dresses, skirts, capris, slacks, shirts and tops)
- Men – Collared shirts and slacks are acceptable.

The following attire is not permitted at any time: shorts, sweatpants, sport clothes, T-shirts, overalls, flip-flops, hats, caps, and blue jeans.

BISTRO – Every Day

- Women's Attire - Nice casual attire is appropriate, including:
 - Dresses
 - Skirts
 - Capris
 - Dress slacks or long pants
 - Blouses, shirts, and dress tops
- Men's Attire - The following attire is appropriate:
 - Collared dress shirts or collared casual shirts
 - Dress slacks
 - Sport coats and ties are welcome but not required

The following attire is not permitted at any time: shorts, sweatpants, sports or athletic clothing, T-shirts, overalls, hats, caps, flip-flops, jeans of any fabric or color.

CAFÉ, BREW BAR, and SPORTS BAR

- Casual, exercise, and work clothes are acceptable.
- Shoes, sandals, or other forms of footwear are always required.
- Visitors and children should wear age-appropriate clothing that adheres to the dress code.

The following attire is not permitted at any time: clothing with words, drawings, or pictures that could be offensive to others; clothing with holes or showing extreme wear and tear; hats; and caps.

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- It is the resident's and future resident's responsibility to inform visitors of the dress code.
 - Current fashions will always be considered.

****The culinary personnel may grant dress code exceptions***
