Biography

You Never Know by Tom Selleck. This intimate memoir by well-known actor Tom Selleck is frank and heartfelt. Mr. Selleck takes us on a “serendipitous” journey from his childhood and college days to his Hollywood fame. It is his personal story written with humor and humility.

Bits and Pieces: My Mother, My Brother, and Me by Whoopi Goldberg. A new and “unique” memoir of Whoopi’s family, and how they influenced her early life. It is a “moving” tribute to her mother and brother and how their love for each other shaped who she was to become.

Fiction

Act of Defiance by Tom Clancy. Another in the Jack Ryan series. Here President Ryan is faced with a nuclear Russian submarine racing toward the East Coast of the United States. Ryan has military might at his command, but not the why and how of this vessel. Be ready for a suspenseful, action packed read.

Camino Ghosts by John Grisham. This is book 3 in the Camino Island series. The setting is Santa Rosa, a resort town on Camino Island in Florida. Here bookseller Bruce Cable and novelist Mercer Mann are again finding trouble in “paradise.” Greedy developers want to own a largely deserted island between Florida and Georgia that may be haunted. Can this pair save the only island inhabitant and the island itself from these developers? It is a “wild but smart” story.

Swan Song by Elin Hilderbrand. The last Nantucket novel by this author. Rich strangers move to this island and social “mayhem” results. There may also be a murder. Can the residents of Nantucket solve the crime and save their way of life on the island? It is a “brilliant end” to this series.

Summers at the Saint by Mary Kay Andrews. A “mesmerizing mix of mystery and romance” The setting is St. Cecelia, a well-known hotel known as the “Saint,” on the coast of Georgia. We find mystery, old, buried secrets, scandal, and second chances.

Mind Games by Nora Roberts (**Large Print**). A new novel by this author. It is full of suspense, tragedy, and trauma. A family will have to deal with a possible “vision” of evil that may be lurking. If it is a game, will love and family triumph?

The Museum of Lost Quilts by Jennifer Chiaverini (**Large Print**). This is number 22 in the Elm Creek Quilts series. Summer Sullivan, the youngest founding member of the Elm Creek Quilts, is returning home. And there seems to be controversy about her latest quilt collection as well as her pursuit of renovating a historical society’s hall. This is a “warm and deeply moving” story.

Mystery

One Perfect Couple by Ruth Ware. This is a mystery ala Agatha Christie. Five couples are stranded on a stormy island as a killer hides among them. This story is filled with intrigue, and true-to-life characters. Will the killer be found in time? It is a “high-tension and ingenious thriller.”

Think Twice by Harlan Coben (**Large Print**). Book 12 of the Myron Bolitar series. When sports agent Myron Bolitar gives the eulogy for his friend, he is unaware that this person is actually alive and wanted for murder. He and this friend encounter a dangerous world as they seek the truth. This suspenseful mystery is rampant with secrets, lies and a “murderous” conspiracy.
