14 Day Books-Mini-Overviews

Fiction

Ghost Soldier by Clive Cussler. This is book 18 in the Oregon Files series; it is a new exploit with Juan Cabrillo and the Oregon crew. The crew is facing a deadly war game, and their adversaries are using weapons so sophisticated that they have never been seen before. A “pulse-pounding” new adventure.

The Midnight Feast by Lucy Foley. It is opening night in The Manor, a new luxurious resort. But beneath the glitter hides dark and, perhaps, deadly secrets. The story has been described as “a smartly paced blend of folk horror, psychological thriller and social satire.”

Breaking the Dark by Lisa Jewell. This is the beginning of a Jessica Jones Marvel Crime series. Private investigator Jessica Jones is a “retired superhero” who distances herself from others. She decides to take the case of teenage twins whose mother is certain that something unnatural has happened to change them while they were in the UK. It is one of this author’s most “imaginative” stories.

By Any Other Name by Jodi Picoult. A story of two women, centuries apart, who both must hide being whom they are. A tale of “intertwining” timelines where these women are determined to create “something beautiful” despite the gender prejudices they face. It is about courage and determination against all odds. Historical fiction at its best!

Proof by Fern Michaels (**Large Print**). Book 4 in the Lost and Found series featuring Luna Bodman and her brother Cullen. Luna’s discovery of a box of memories leads to a search into her past and a questionable death. The tale combines mystery, drama, and romance.

Mystery

Vince Flynn Capture or Kill by Don Bentley. Another Mitch Rapp. Here Mitch Rapp is in the Middle East dealing with an Iranian enemy who wants to “destabilize” the region. Can Mitch prevent another war and bring justice for those Americans killed in 911?

On the Hunt by Iris Johansen. Here is a new series featuring heroine Kira Drake and her search-and-rescue dog Mack. They are searching for a killer in Paris who also may be responsible for the bombing of a museum near the Eiffel Tower. It is a fast-paced thriller.

Confessions of the Dead by James Patterson and J.D. Barker. Described as one of the “scariest thrillers,” the mystery takes place in a picturesque small New England town where no crime has ever taken place. What dark secrets does this town hold?

The Lost Coast by Jonathan and Jesse Kellerman (**Large Print**). Book 5 in the Clay Edison series where Clay is now a private investigator. A case of simple fraud he becomes involved in turns into a web of deception and a con game with victims going back decades. The book is “busting” with action, suspense, deception, and noteworthy characters.

Fire and Bones by Kathy Reich (**Large Print**). This is book 23 in the Temperance Brennan series. Forensic anthropologist Brennan is in the middle of a Washington, D.C. arson investigation. This investigation becomes fraught with mystery and violence. It is a “twisty, unputdownable” fast-paced thriller.
