This week, we had some very exciting news when Bridgewater achieved 100% occupancy! Congratulations to the team at Bridgewater; you have done a fantastic job growing the business and enhancing the lives of our residents!

A few reminders to share today:

- The Culinary Committee established a dress code for each of our dining venues. It is your responsibility to adhere to the dress code. Please be respectful of your neighbors and our staff when coming to dine by adhering to the proper dress code. The most recent dress code can be found on the portal;
